DoD ATS Policy

- New DoD 5000.1 and 5000.2 were signed out 12 May 2003 but contain no policy directly related to Automatic Test Systems
 - The ATS Architecture Framework is included in the ATS Subdomain within the Combat Support Domain of the Joint Technical Architecture (JTA)
- OSD (AT&L) will issue ATS policy via letter in near future and will insert ATS policy in new DoD Instruction 4000 (Defense Logistics System) which is currently in development

- Bottom line remains same:
 - Services are continuing to do business as prior to the 5000.1/.2 updates

ATS Executive Agent Assessment

- In response to the GAO audit of DoD ATS, OSD tasked Navy (ASN RDA) to lead a Joint Service team to assess the ATS EA function
- Team formed and has been working since June
- Identified and evaluated 3 alternatives:
 - 1: Continue business as usual.
 - 2: Continue business as usual but with an enhanced MOA signed by the Service Acquisition Executives that established stronger Joint policy
 - 3: Formally implement an EA per DoD Instruction 5101.1
- Meet with AMB tomorrow to select the alternative to recommend to OSD
- Final Report to OSD AT&L by 25 November

ATS Management Board

- AMB meets tomorrow
- Major discussion items are ARGCS status, Framework plans, and EA Assessment Report
- Capt Spangler, SOCOM rep, retires later this fall. Relief TBD.
- LCOL Juliano retires in October. Relief is LCOL Dan McLean.

Other Interest Items

- More aggressively addressing the DoD ATS Framework
- Continue to identify and Jointly work new technologies (NxTest technologies)
 - ATML
 - Smarter TPSs
- Focused on getting ARGCS demonstration underway
 - FY04 start
