






Four C's and an S

 - This means change management






Why An Intranet?

NMCI is infrastructure for FORCEnet



A long-term service agreement with the commercial sector based upon a commercial model

- Awarded 6 Oct 2000
- Largest seat management contract in the world
- Five-year Firm Fixed Price FAR Part 12 contract with three year option
 - Congress recently approved 2 year extension of base contract
 - Potential \$8.8 B value
 - FY 04 request \$1.591B



Seats Managed (K)




According to the Gartner Group, NMCI will eventually comprise 4% of the total U.S. managed seat market

- From Government PC to Commercial Service Delivery


