





Virtual Flag

- Quarterly joint distributed flag exercises
 - Robust air-land-maritime-space-emitter training environments
 - Focused on integrated C2ISR execution across current and evolving Combat Air Forces mission areas
- Scenarios designed to support Combatant Commanders
- Combined with Red Flag and/or Blue Flag







Future Allied Involvement


- Mission Training through Distributed Simulation (MTDS) exercise First WAVE
 - Seven nations including US and The Netherlands
 - Combined Air Operations (COMAO) scenarios
 - Demo potential of coalition MTDS (DMO)
- Coalition Mission Training Research (CMTR)
 - ACC/DOT, Air Force Research Lab (AFRL)
 - Developed common architecture to define MTDS training objectives
 - Mission-level objectives transfer among coalition members



Exercise First WAVE

First Warfighter Alliance in a Virtual Environment

- Long-haul connectivity between N. American and European ATM cloud
- Sixteen sites presents some technical and operational challenges






Commercial Training Simulation Services (CTSS)

- CTSS is not DMO
- CTSS is
 - A non-traditional acquisition strategy AF doesn't own the sims
 - A contractor provided service for system development, support, upgrades, concurrency w/aircraft
- Must have funding tail from Decision to Activate (DTA) through contract end
 - Funded with 3400 O & M funds (1-year money)
 - Once activated, each site is a must-pay bill
 - Cannot use fall-out funds for DTA
- Insufficient funding caused site activations to slip; contracts at risk



Commercial Training Simulation Services (CTSS)


- CTSS contract costs are front loaded (cost for services with a minimum guarantee)
 - Significant cost decrease after 3-5 yr
 - Long contract periods are best value for Air Force
- Contractors' revenue tied to start of training services
 - Recover investment in initial (3-5) years' service rates






Current CTSS Status








F-16 B40/50 Roadmap
