- **Services and Agencies – Develop Space Cadre...and Organize, Train, and Equip**

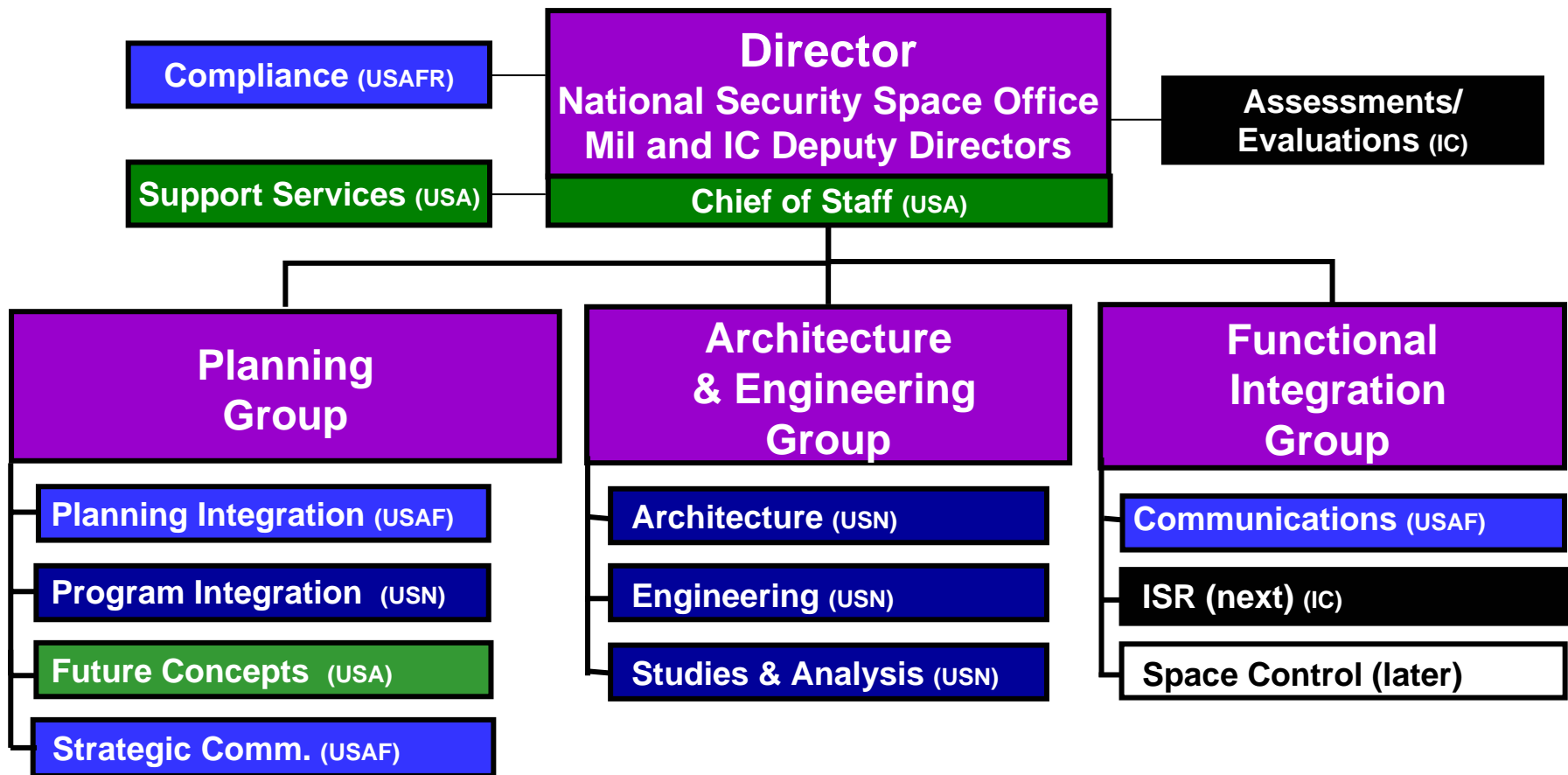

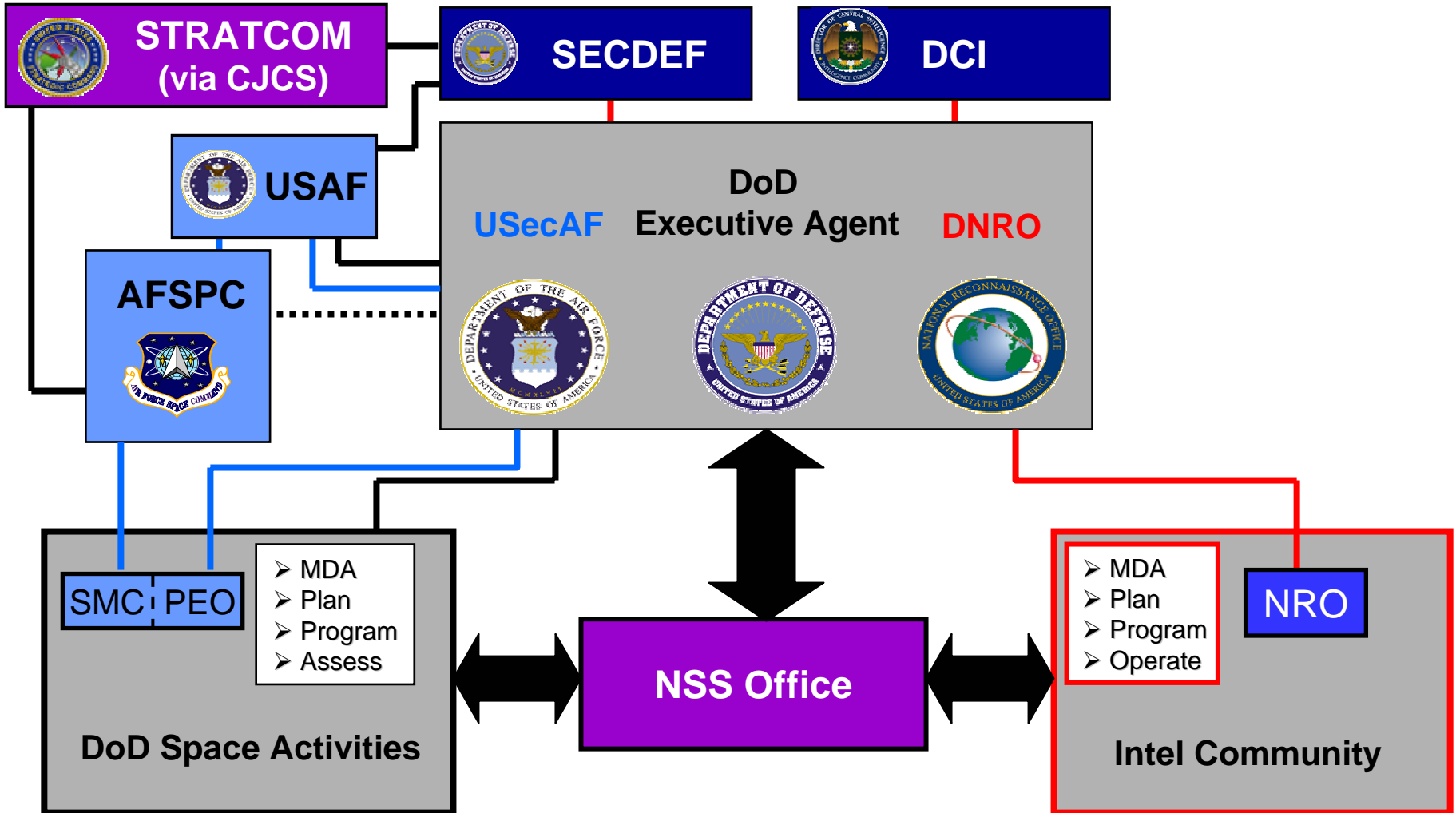

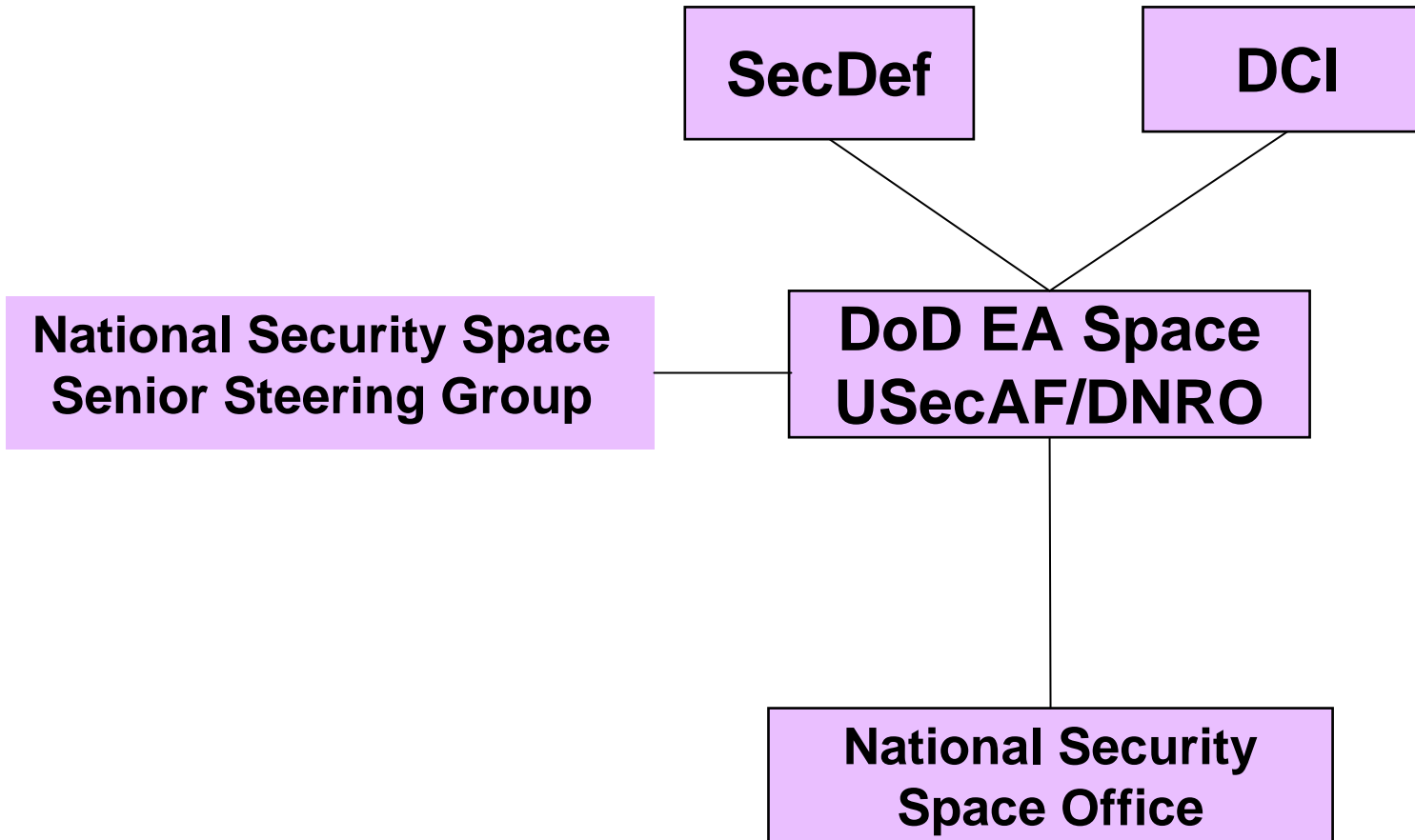
