- 7,100 foot runway





















GSIE Capabilities Enhancedby Continuous Improvement















CRITICAL CAPABILITIES

Depot-level recapitalization, overhaul, repair, modification and conversion of combat tracked vehicles, their components and sub-assemblies, and small arms.



- Special armor repair including a secure facility for special armor repair
- Only AGT-1500 test facility in DoD
- DoD small arms rebuild facility and storage
- Infrastructure capable of supporting combat vehicles in excess of 70 tons
- Surge capacity of 3.2M workhours in 1 shift




