Bomb Acquisition Strategy



- Objective: Create an acquisition "pipeline" that rapidly provides the warfighter with conventional bombs... is flexible, responsive and proactive... improves the health of the industrial base..
 - Consolidate procurements where feasible
 - Group like components (e.g. fins, lugs)
 - Systems contract being evaluated
 - Must improve industrial base alleviate single point failures, promote competition, support small business
 - Must achieve lower cost or provide value for cost premium
 - ➤ Longer-term contract(s) multiple-year, FY06-10
 - Business case analyses underway



Insensitive Munitions (IMI)



Focus on future:

- > IM includes case design and explosive fill modifications
- ➤ Air Force MK 84 bomb IM waiver to expire FY06 explosive fills under evaluation now RDX based
- ➤ Air Force MK 82 bomb IM waiver to expire FY07- explosive fills under evaluation are RDX based
- ➤ Navy expected to adopt common fill once proven



Penetrator Bomb Fuzes



• FMU -143 B/B Fuze

- ➤ Synopsis posted 27 January 2005
- ➤ Issuance of solicitation on/about 14 February 2005
- > ~ 8416 quantity
- ➤ Joint Programmable Fuze (FMU-152) to replace FMU 143 fuze
