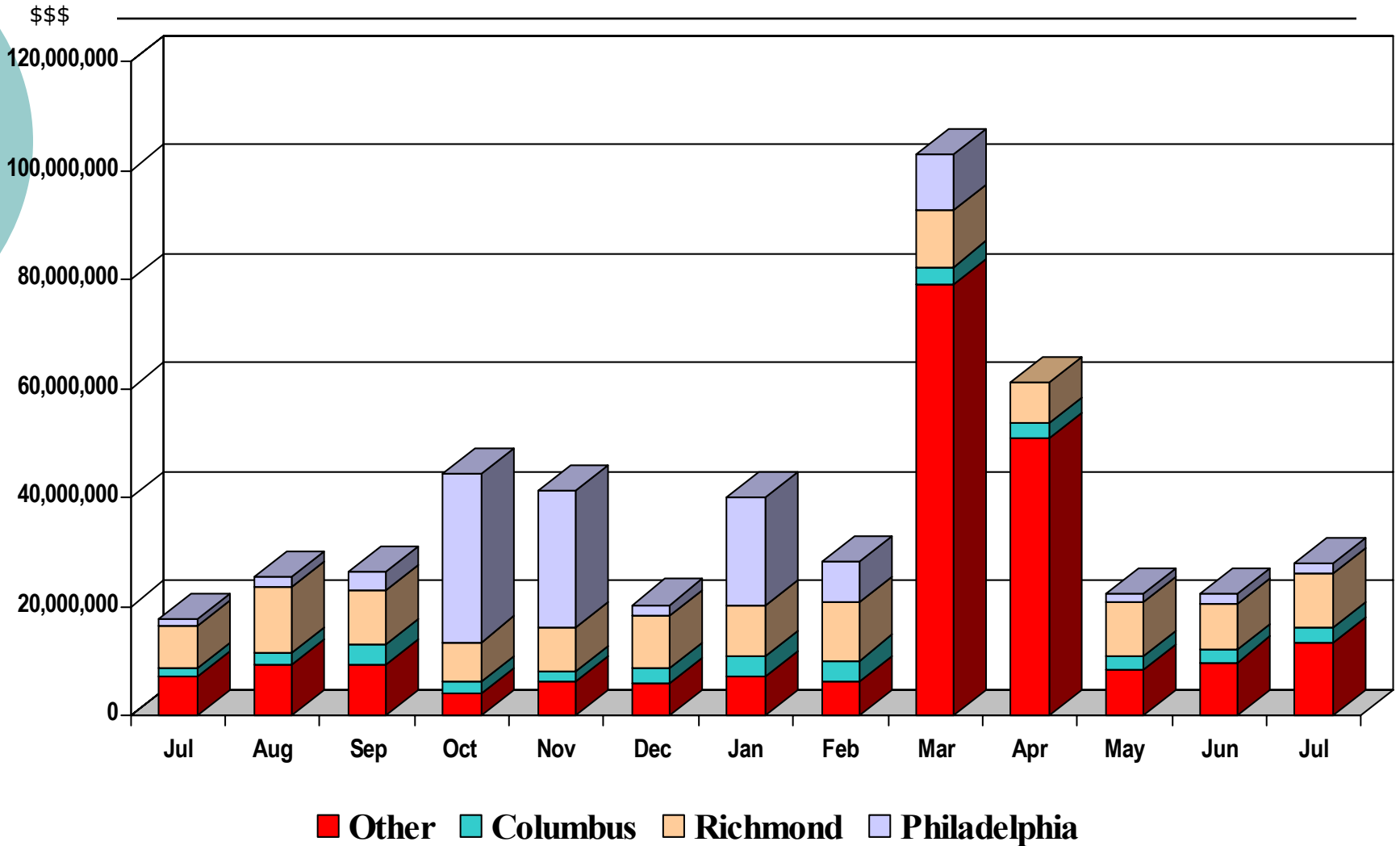
Customers can pay with GPC or MILSTRIP
