

AIRCREW TRAINING SYSTEM







TRAINING SYSTEM COST



- ATS Contracts Valued at \$161M in FY06
 - C-17 Boeing
 - C-5 Flight Safety
 - C-130 Lockheed
 - KC-10 Boeing
 - KC-135 Flight Safety
- **62 Simulators \$1.2B**





PILOT TRAINING IN SIMULATORS



Airframe	Contracted Levels	Sim Creditable Training Events (Approximate)
KC-135	20 hr/day, 6 day/wk	50% proficiency events, 50% tactical events
KC-10	16 hrs/day, 7 day/wk	75% proficiency events, 50% tactical events
C-17	16 hrs/day, 7 day/wk	100% proficiency events, 50% tactical events
C-5	16 hr/day, 360 day/yr	90% proficiency events, 100% tactical events
C-130E/H	18 hr/day, 6 day/wk	100% proficiency events, 50% tactical events
C-130J	20 hr/day, 5 day/wk	100% proficiency events, 50% tactical events

- Threat recognition/avoidance training conducted with VTRAT classroom simulators
- FY06 Cost Avoidance:
 - 31,704 flying hours, equivalent to \$322M in total costs, \$233M in fuel costs



DISTRIBUTED MISSION OPERATIONS



- Networking Simulators For Large Scale Training
 - Airdrop, Air Refueling and Tactics Training to Sims
 - Train With Non-Aircrew Players
 - Allows Mission/Campaign Rehearsal
 - Increased Crew Management Resource (CRM) Training
- Vastly More Realistic Than Single Crew Training







EXPAND BEYOND PILOT-ONLY SIMULATORS



- **Improve Simulator Training For All Crew Positions**
- Network Simulators For Distributed Training









COMMON DATABASES



- **Expands Training Beyond Home Station**
 - Iraq and Afghanistan
- **Essential for Distributed Mission Operations/Training**
 - Formation, Airdrop, Air Refueling







INCORPORATE THREATS TRAINING INTO SIMULATOR



 Current threat training with Virtual Threat Recognition and Avoidance Trainers (VTRAT)

■ Need to take threats into simulators











FUTURE REQUIREMENTS FOR SIMULATOR TRAINING



- Distributed Mission Operations
- **Expansion Beyond Pilot-Only Simulators**
- Common Databases
- Incorporation of Threat Data Directly into Simulators
- Must be Affordable!
