
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

SUBJECT: Designation of Programs for Calendar Year 2007 Office of the Secretary of  
Defense Test and Evaluation Oversight

Department of Defense Instruction (DODI) 5000.2 (Operation of the Defense Acquisition System) states that the Director, Operational Test and Evaluation, and the Director, Defense Systems (now Systems and Software Engineering), will publish annually a list of programs designated for Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) Test and Evaluation (T&E) oversight. The attached list identifies the programs designated for calendar year 2007 and specifies developmental, operational, and live-fire T&E oversight requirements. This list supersedes all previous versions of the OSD T&E Oversight List. This list does not include highly classified and sensitive programs subject to T&E oversight, which are identified directly to the Program Managers.

Unless otherwise indicated, programs designated for operational and live-fire test and evaluation oversight are to be considered as Major Defense Acquisition and covered programs subject to the provisions of 10USC139, 2366, and 2399 and to the requirements of DODI 5000.2 for T&E Strategies (TESs), System Threat Assessments, T&E Master Plans (TEMPs), Operational T&E Plans, and reporting test results. For each program on the list, Program Offices shall submit to OSD the appropriate supporting documentation as required by DODI 5000.2. Submit all TESs and TEMPs to the Director, Systems and Software Engineering (Attn: SSE/Assessments and Support), Pentagon Room 3E130, for OSD approval processing.
