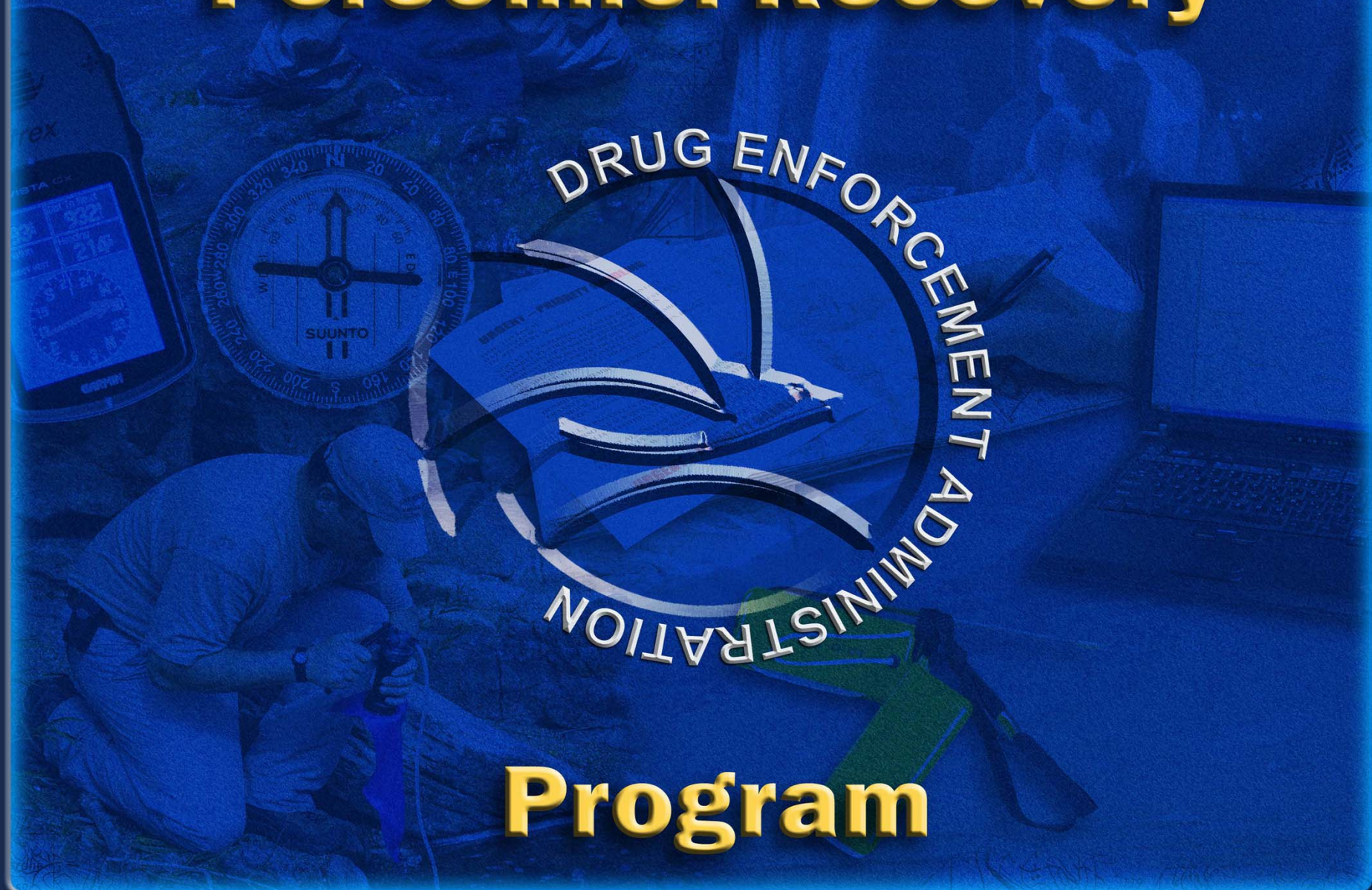

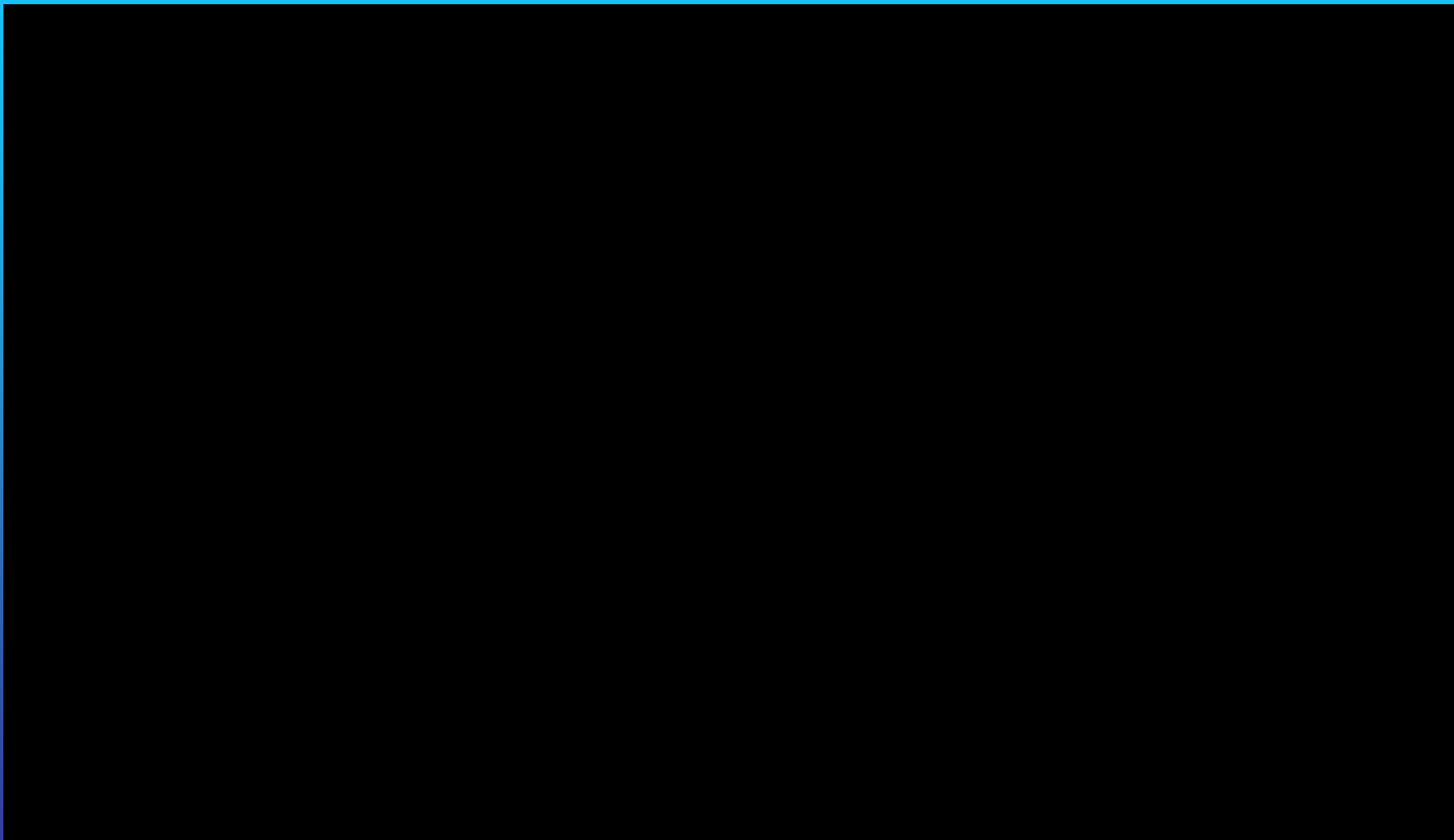

Initial Survey Responses

- *“Our agency needs more than a paper emergency plan so that its employees may remain safe”*
- *“I hope whatever comes out of this survey is for everyone, not just 1811s and that any capability of recovering personnel is applicable to all “.*
- *“We need training period. We also need Headquarters in DC to recognize the dangers and plan accordingly”!*
- *“Often when programs are developed, even with the best intentions they end up being watered down or given to the low bidder”.*
- *“A Good “How to avoid being captured or hostage” training and what to do if captured...how to survive during captivity”*

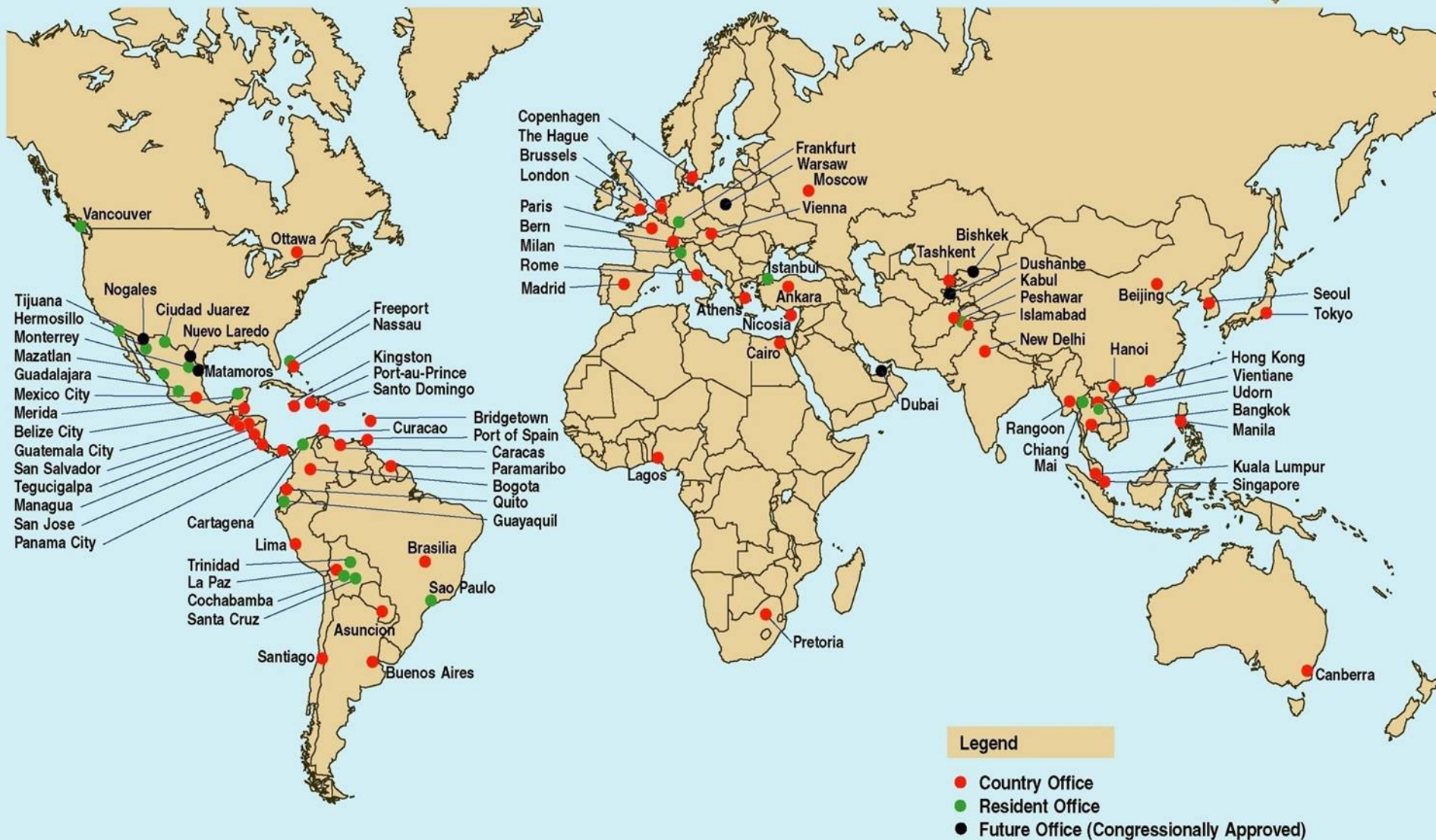
