






- Develop a focused National investment strategy

USJFCOM Perspective

- We need an efficient and effective Global Synthetic Environment solution that enables Unified Action.
- The Global Synthetic Environment is the combination of live, virtual, and constructive simulations that support training, experimentation, acquisition, test, analysis and planning.
- Evolution of our current capabilities is not enough; we must transform our approach to modeling and simulation.
