## Ports, Waterways, and Coastal Security (PWCS)

- > Four PWCS areas of interest:
  - Transportation Worker Identity Credential (TWIC)
  - Port Security Grant Program (PSGP)
  - Small Vessel Security
  - Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA)









### Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)

- Anticipate that TWIC enrollments will begin in the fall of 2007 beginning with the Port of Wilmington, DE.
- September 25, 2008, Mariner and OCS Facility compliance date remains in effect.
- Contactless biometric specification / card reader specification is in the final stages of review.



### \$110M - FY07 Port Security Grant Supplement

- Funds must be awarded by September 30, 2007.
- Tier I & II Ports identify a Fiduciary Agent (FA) to perform oversight duties. FA can retain up to 3% of award funds for mgmt & admin costs.
- FA can be a member of the Area Maritime Security Committee (AMSC), Non-Profit, or any entity approved in conjunction with the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.
- FA coordinates development of a Port-Wide Risk Management/ Mitigation and Busines Continuity/Resumption of Trade Plan.



#### **Small Vessel Security**

- DHS hosted National Small Vessel Security Summit in June 2007.
  - Input from the Summit is still being compiled and a final report should be published by November.
  - The Coast Guard is working on a follow-up DHS workgroup to develop a national strategy.
  - Regional summits are in the planning stage for six U.S. ports later this year.







#### Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA)

- ➤ MDA = Global Maritime Intelligence plus Global Maritime Situational Awareness
- Supports all missions & all levels of decision-making
  - Strategic, Operational & Tactical
- > Provides Common Operational Picture (COP)

> Requires collaboration among local/state/federal

government, private sector, & international stakeholders.

- > USCG Priorities:
- Support National & DHS MDA Efforts
- ➤ Improve CG MDA in support of Mission Execution
- Identify & fill capability gaps
  - Use current & emerging technology
  - Partner with maritime stakeholders
