

“Resetting the Force” (MARSOC)

- ↑ Establishment of the **MARSOC** (Increased SOF capacity)
- ↑ Internal **reorganization** of the MARSOC (balance kinetic operations and indirect activities)
- ↑ Creation of the **MARSOF** Warrior; concept of the “**Strategic Sergeant**” (organic Schoolhouse)
- ↑ Foster an **Irregular Warfare** mindset (post OIF/OEF)
- ↑ Understand the impact of **Globalization** and the inevitable transition to “**Modernity**”
- ↑ Greater **integration** of operations, intelligence, and logistics
- ↑ Regional focus; Invest in **language** and **culture**
- ↑ Enhance capability to conduct **split-based** operations, increase **ISR** coverage (persistent), conduct **F3EA** activities, expand **Identity Dominance** capability, expand participation in **Information Operations** efforts, and improve **Knowledge Management** across the force.
