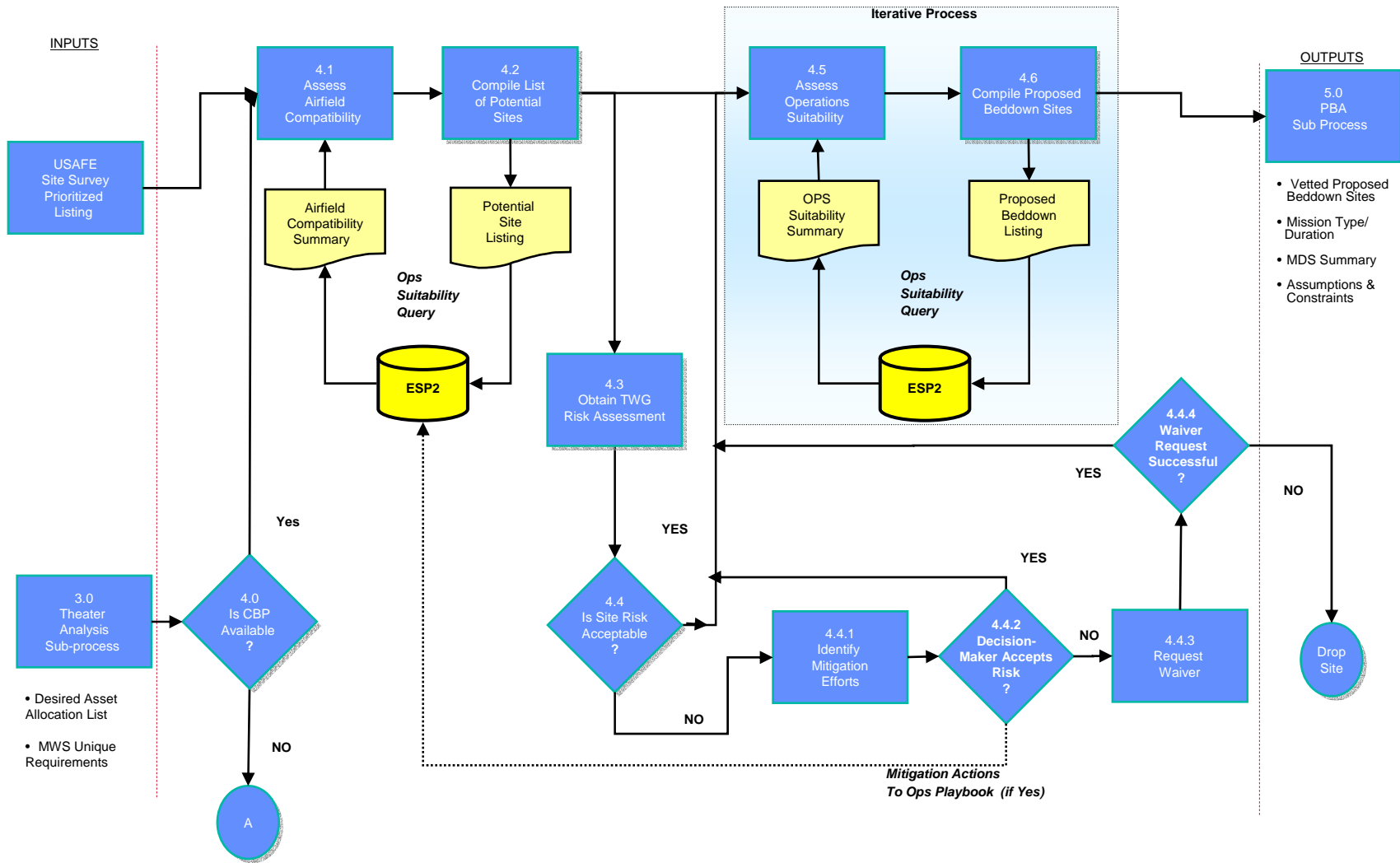

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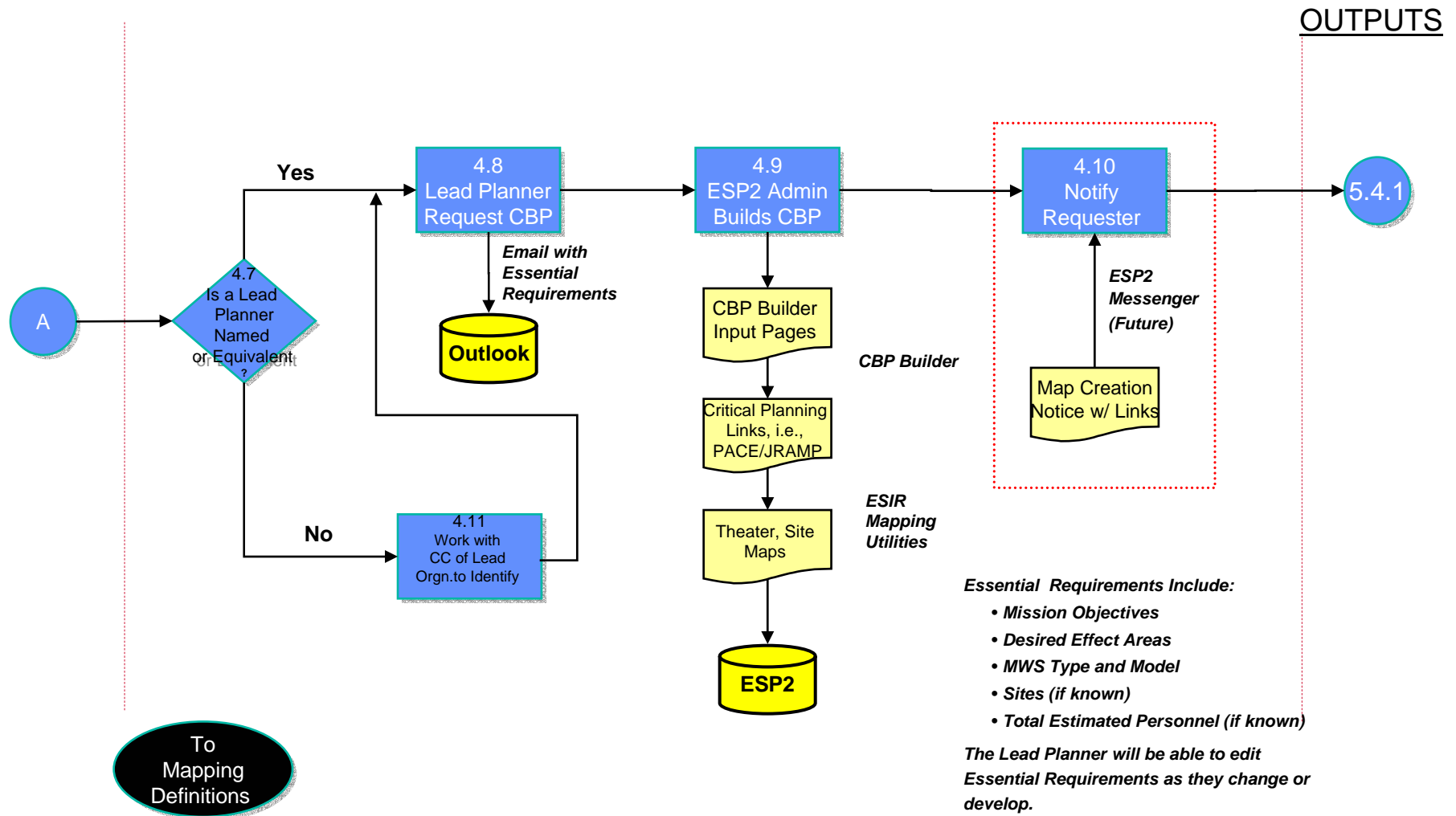
ESP2 Sub-Process 4.0 (Site Selection)

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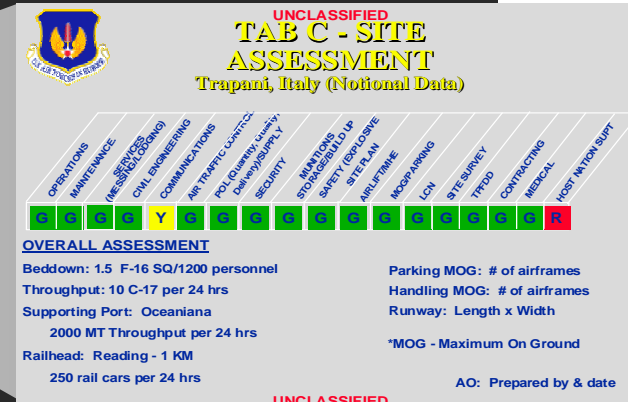
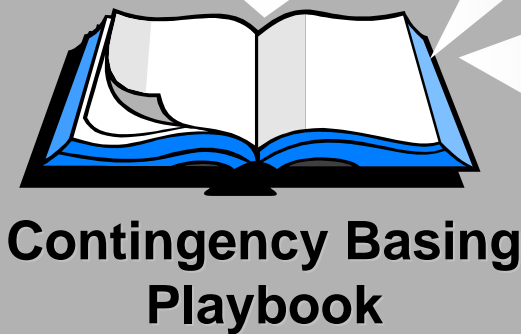
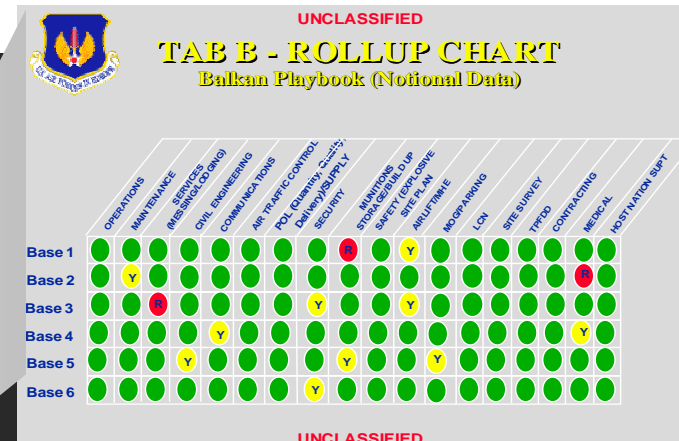
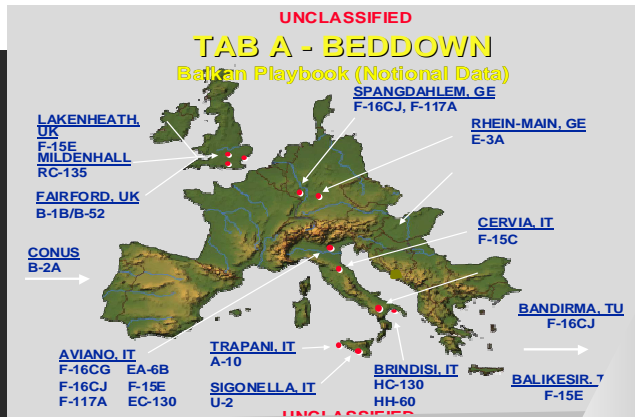


Contingency Basing Playbooks

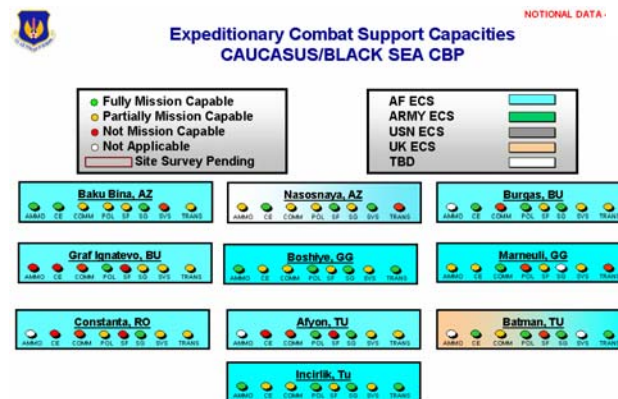
