EVM - OSD Perspective

- EVM information is a fundamental component of program decision making and oversight
 - DoD acquisition management processes
 Milestone Decision process, Selected
 Acquisition Reports (SARs), and Defense
 Acquisition Executive Summary (DAES).
 - Nunn-McCurdy certification process.

Senior leadership relies on EVM information!



EVM - OSD Activities

- Review contractor cost performance information for Major Defense Acquisition Programs (MDAPs)
 - As part of the monthly DAES process
 - Programs submit a DAES report quarterly
 - 1/3 of the programs report each month
 - As follow-on activity for programs with Nunn-McCurdy unit cost breaches
 - Review monthly EVM information for 6 programs that USD(AT&L) certified to Congress in 2002
 - EVM info serves as early warning sign of program challenges.
 - About 75 programs are reviewed.



- Program Related Site Visits
 - SBIRS High program Integrated Baseline Review (IBR)
 - Training session October 2002
 - Outbrief to Program Manager November 2002
 - Program Assessment to USD(AT&L) on January 27, 2003
 - USMC H-1 Senior Executive Review Board (SERB)
 - Meeting at Bell Helicopters on January 16-17, 2003

Program office staff frequently visit the Pentagon.



- NDIA Member Involvement
 - Provided quarterly EVM brief by Boeing EVM focal points –
 October 24
 - Attended Lockheed Martin EVM Management Council meeting November 21
 - Plan to visit Northrop Grumman Electronic Systems site

Plan to stay engaged.



- DoD EVM Integrated Product Team
 - First meeting held at the 14th Annual International Integrated Program Management Conference
 - Attendees included representatives from DCMA, Army, Navy, Air Force, MDA, DAU
 - Each organization made a short presentation on the state of EVM from that organization's perspective, with an emphasis on areas that need improvement.

Re-engaged DoD EVM IPT.



- EVM International participation
 - Participated in the 1st UK Performance Management Symposium in October 2002.
 - Frequent correspondence with Australian Program
 Manager for Earned Value Management

Plan to expand international participation.

EVM - DoD Priorities

- Ensure that EVM contributes to improved contractor program management.
 - Ensure DCMA is focused on surveillance function and make sure people are properly trained.
 - Ensure DCMA has current (i.e., signed by current PM)
 MOAs with all program offices.
 - Ensure that government PMs place EVM on contract effectively.

Sometimes PMs direct contractors to take measures that directly contradict EVM policies and principles.



EVM - DoD Priorities

(cont'd)

- Ensure that DoD acquisition community
 has an awareness of when Over-Target
 Baselines (OTBs) are necessary for proper
 program management.
 - Reflects an awareness of EVM as a management process rather than a required report.
- Ensure contractors have management systems capable of producing reliable EVM data.
- Address EVM specialist and analyst workforce needs.



EVM - DoD Priorities

(cont'd)

Update DoD EVM policy and guidance documents.

- EVM Implementation Guide
 - Synchronize with DCMA "One Book" and policy documents
- Data Item Descriptions (DIDs) Cost Performance Report (CPR), Contract Funds Status Report (CFSR), and possibly Cost/Schedule Status Report (C/SSR)

Continue partnership with NDIA.

 Integrated Baseline Review (IBR) Guide for Program Managers has been revised by NDIA and DoD. Document is in DoD coordination process.

Target for signature/publication is ASAP.
